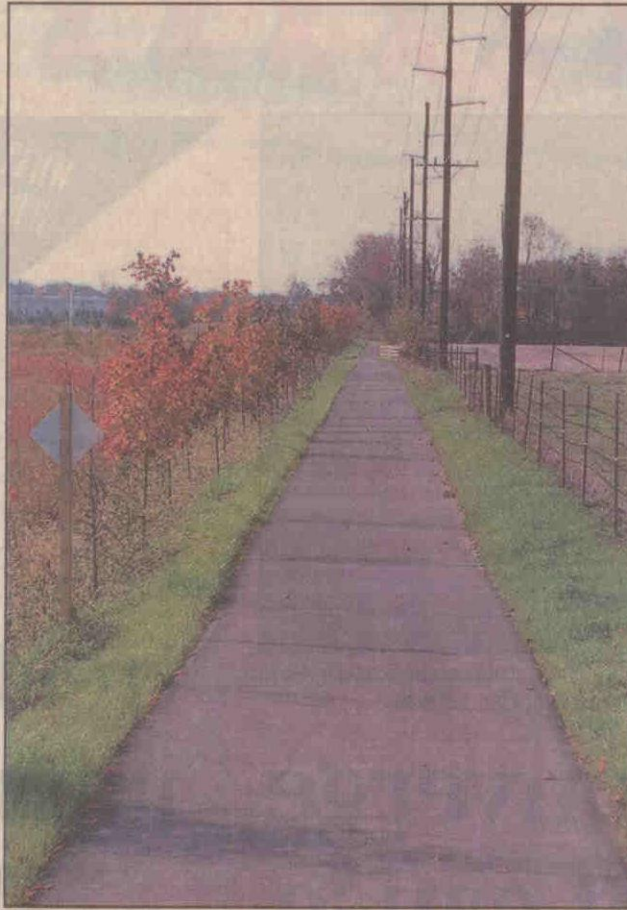

## Plainfield completes Metropolis Pedestrian Trail

The newest addition to Plainfield's award-winning pedestrian trail system is a .64 mile Metropolis Mall trail connector. Extending from Southfield Drive on the south to Metropolis Parkway to the north, the trail includes the pedestrian tunnel beneath Quaker Boulevard (State Road 267) near the former Lincoln Bank headquarters. This newest trail section is part of an overall 20-mile network of pathways and sidewalks that make it easier and safer for residents and visitors to enjoy Plainfield on foot or bicycle. Plainfield's trail system connects 95 percent of the town's major residential neighborhoods. The \$204,000 project was designed by Eagle Ridge Civil Engineering Services and was constructed by Harco Asphalt Paving. Inspection services were provided by BFS Engineering.
